RESOLUTION NO. 2889, S-2020

A RESOLUTION GRANTING TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) CALAMITY ASSISTANCE TO EACH MEMBER OF THE TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS' ASSOCIATIONS (TODAs) AND JEEPNEY OPERATORS AND DRIVERS' ASSOCIATIONS (JODAs) IN MANDALUYONG CITY WHO ARE GREATLY AFFECTED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, there is an emergence of a novel corona virus (COVID-19) that have been acknowledged by the global community to cause public health emergencies of international concern;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) has already made the assessment that COVID-19 as a pandemic;

WHEREAS, on 12 March 2020, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) per Resolution No. 11, Series of 2020, raised the COVID-19 threat to the highest alert level, Code Red Sublevel 2, due to the evidence of sustained community transmission of the disease;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte approved the recommendation to declare a community quarantine in the National Capital Region (NCR) on 15 March 2020, and, on 17 March 2020, the recommendation to declare an Enhanced Community Quarantine in the entirety of Luzon;

WHEREAS, the declaration of Enhanced Community Quarantine and the imposition of Stringent Social Distancing Measures affected the population's mobility as ingress and egress to and from NCR have been restricted, causing the implementation of alternative working arrangements in government and private offices, suspension of operations or closure of business establishments, suspension of public mass transportation, imposition of curfew hours, and implementation of heightened community quarantine by some local government units (LGUs);

WHEREAS, despite the protocols imposed relative to the Enhanced Community Quarantine, the struggle of the Filipino families for economic survival continues. Apparently, despite knowing the reports of the increasing number of persons being monitored and investigated for COVID-19 as well as the number of deaths, people feel compelled to provide for their families, thus, evading quarantine protocols in the process;

WHEREAS, the City of Mandaluyong, in partnership with the private sector, is doing all its best to alleviate the hapless conditions of the people, especially the poor and marginalized, including those displaced from work or source of livelihood;

WHEREAS, one of those greatly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic are the tricycle and jeepney operators and drivers in Mandaluyong City, whose source of income was practically halted due to the enforcement of the Enhanced Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, as an ongoing effort to reach out and lend a helping hand to the poor and marginalized sectors in Mandaluyong City, a cash assistance in this time of calamity is imperative to be given to the tricycle and jeepney operators and drivers in order to buy food and medicine for their families.


NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to grant, extend or give a one-time cash calamity assistance to each member of Tricycle Operators and Drivers' Associations (TODAs) and Jeepney Operators and Drivers' Associations (JODAs) in Mandaluyong City in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) who are greatly affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the amount necessary to extend the calamity assistance shall be taken from the Special Trust Fund under the City's Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF).

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, City Budget Department, City Accounting Department and City Treasurer's Department for information and guidance.
